

Our new battery program includes access to thousands of batteries and battery accessories that, if not in stock, we can generally get for you within a few days. We can correctly identify the batteries for more than 100,000 devices! We have access to batteries for electronic devices such as cordless and cellular phones, cameras, camcorders, laptops, lighting fixtures, and power tools.

We can also get you batteries for motorcycles, scooters, and personal watercraft, too! Stop by any of our stores, and one of our friendly crew members can assist you. ## Batteries 101

Over the years we have become a society quite dependent on batteries for nearly everything in our daily lives: mobile phones, computers, cars, hearing aids. You name it! Batteries convert chemical energy to electrical energy to power our lifestyles and the world. The two types of batteries in use today are primary, or disposable, batteries and secondary, or rechargeable, batteries.

**Disposable batteries** are used for portable devices with a low current drain, such as flashlights. Two common types include zinc carbon and alkaline, which are both dry cell batteries, meaning they contain no liquid. Once these batteries are drained of energy, they cannot be recharged. These are available in standard sizes AA, AAA, C, D, and 9-volt batteries. Button-style batteries that are used in cameras or watches, for example, also fall into this category.



**Rechargeable batteries** must be charged before use and can be recharged over and over again. A car battery is a lead-acid battery and one of the oldest rechargeable types of batteries. Dry cell-type rechargeable batteries are sealed units and used commonly to power laptops and mobile phones.

Common dry cell rechargeable batteries include lithium ion (Li-ion), used in many power tool applications, and nickel metal hydride (NiMH), used in everyday battery sizes, such as AA, AAA, C, D, and 9-volt. Other rechargeable batteries include nickel zinc (NiZn) and nickel cadmium (NiCd).

We stock several chargers for rechargeable batteries. The Energizer® battery kit comes with four AA batteries and can charge either two or four AA or AAA batteries at a time. This kit features a sleek compact design

ideal for travel and includes four AA batteries. (Sku 3193018, \$29.99) Another charger we offer will charge multiple combinations of AA, AAA, C, D, or 9-volt batteries. (Sku 3106416, \$24.99) Both of these models will recharge nickel metal hydride (NiMH) batteries.

Because all batteries contain chemicals, it is extremely important that they be recycled to keep them out of the landfill. You can drop off spent AA, AAA, C, D, and 9-volt batteries at any COLE HARDWARE location. Used batteries are recycled properly through our partnership with the San Francisco Department of Environment's recycling program.

### July Garden Tasks

We should be well into our dry season by now. Don't let your garden dry out. Watering early in the morning is ideal. Evening watering is preferable to watering in the heat of the day, but it can promote disease. Weeds steal valuable water, so make sure to keep them under control. The long summer days provide an ideal opportunity to enjoy your garden.

✓ **Fertilize:** Annuals, perennials, and trees will all enjoy a boost of nitrogen. Use an all-purpose fertilizer. After azaleas, camellias, and rhododendrons have finished blooming, use an acid-loving plant food on these.

✓ **Plant herbs:** In a sunny area of your garden, plant culinary herbs such as cilantro, dill, rosemary, thyme, parsley, mint, and chives.



✓ **Tomatoes:** On a sunny windowsill, tomato seeds can still be started indoors. If your outdoor tomato plants have purpling or yellowing, this probably indicates a nutritional deficiency, and only then should they be fertilized. Irregular watering during a heat wave (should we be so fortunate) can cause rapid growth, but it is not good on the fruit.



✓ **Vegetables:** Plant a second crop of vegetables now: beets, bush beans, carrots, radishes, cabbage, cauliflower, fava beans, and turnips.

Harvesting your vegetables while they are young and on a regular basis will keep them productively fruiting. Harvest early in the day.

✓ **Butterfly-loving plants:** To attract butterflies to your garden, it is essential to plant nectar-producing flowers for them to feed on. Consider these plants:



- Flowers: Goldenrod, milkweed, sunset, marigolds, cosmos, Mexican sunflowers, and phlox
- Vegetables: Broccoli, kale, and cabbage
- Herbs: Catnip, lavender, thyme, dill, sage, and parsley



✓ **Aphids:** Combat aphids with a strong spray from the hose, with ladybugs, or with Safer® Insecticidal Soap. (Sku 74805, \$8.99) Release ladybugs in the evening at the base of the plant. If released during daytime, the ladybugs will fly away. As the ladybugs crawl up the plant, they will feast on the aphids.

✓ **Moisture meters:** Watering properly is important—both to not waste water and to assure plants are getting what they need. If you aren't sure if your garden is getting the right amount of water, invest in a moisture meter, so you can water only when necessary. (Sku 7011638, \$7.99)



✓ **Color:** Now is the time to plant summer flowering perennials, shrubs, and annuals. Marigolds, petunias, salvia, and begonias should all do the trick to make your garden bright and colorful.

✓ **DriWater®:** If you are vacationing this month and don't have a reliable person to water your garden or houseplants, DriWater is what you need. DriWater is a patented product that consists of 98% purified water and 2% foodgrade ingredients. It is bound in the form of a gel-like solid that provides consistent subsurface irrigation







## The Lighting Laws and Lumens

In May we featured an article on the new lighting laws, a result of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007, which went into effect in 2011. The legislation is intended to phase out traditional incandescent bulbs, which are essentially unchanged since the time of Thomas Edison, and phase in more energy-efficient bulbs such as halogen, compact fluorescent (CFL), and light-emitting diode (LED) bulbs.

Consumers will notice new packaging that now highlights lumens, or brightness. Lumens measure light output and the "new watts" which measure the amount of energy a bulb consumes. An avid *Hardware Hotline* reader asked if we could please include a chart on what to look for in order to achieve the same level of light from the new bulbs compared with bulbs we used in the past.



Old Wattage	Now Look For	Maximum Wattage of New Bulbs
95–100 watts	1,490–2,600 lumens	72 watts
71–75 watts	1,050–1,489 lumens	53 watts
57–60 watts	750–1,049 lumens	43 watts

CFLs, tubes up to 8 feet, U- and D-shaped tubes. Drop-off limit is 10 bulbs.



### SCRAP METAL:

Copper and brass.

### EXPIRED PRINTER CARTRIDGES:

Must be in plastic bags to avoid leakage.

### SOFT PLASTIC RECYCLING:

Clean plastic only. Households only. One basketball-size amount per visit please.


## Fynboss Flora: Our Source for "Geraniums"
