
Conservatory of Flowers

Diary of a Community Forester

As I reported in last month's Hardware Hotline, I recently signed up for Friends of the Urban Forest's Community Forester training program—a six-week program designed to help individuals become volunteer arborists in San Francisco.

Our latest classroom lectures and fieldwork have pertained to pruning trees, as well as





hands-on planting sessions for both trees and sidewalk succulent gardens. We learned the proper methods of young tree training and structural pruning for both fruit trees and non-fruit trees. Our crew then took our pruners to work at the Kaiser fruit tree garden, on the corner of Geary and Divisadero, and at the Alta Vista School and surrounding neighborhood to test

out our new knowledge. We planted cork oaks in the Bernal Heights neighborhood, and then we helped plant a sidewalk garden in the Outer Mission. Lastly,

we participated in a roundtable presentation and discussion about outreach, advocacy, and tree laws in San Francisco. As Dr. Seuss famously wrote, "I am the Lorax. I speak for the trees. I speak for the trees for the trees have no tongues."

Tips from Our Garden Expert

Though we have been enjoying springlike weather pretty much since January, spring has now officially sprung. Hopefully the old adage "April showers bring May flowers" will hold true for us this season, as we still have months worth of catch-up to play with rainfall. Use the extra hours of daylight now to get your garden well prepared for the summer and fall months ahead. Again, during dry-weather months in the Bay Area, watering wisely will be crucial this

✓ Water wisely: It's best to water your plants early in the morning or during evening. Doing so reduces the amount of water lost to evaporation. Watering early

in the day is preferable because wet foliage from evening watering makes plants susceptible to fungal diseases. We offer a wide variety of watering cans (Sku 7503659, \$24.99), as well as a

several timers (Sku 7362528, \$36.99) you can set to automatically turn on and off to save water. Water directly at the foot of the plant.

Plant vegetables: It's time to plant vegetables for summer harvest. Remember that leafy



vegetables need at least six hours of sunlight to develop fully. Fruiting vegetables such as tomatoes, peppers, squash, and eggplant require about 10 hours

of sunlight. Choose the right location for planting. (Botanical Interest Seed Packets, \$1.59-\$5.99)

✓ Plant annuals: Sow seeds now for summer- and fallblooming annuals. Set out container-grown annuals such as impatiens, petunias, nasturtium,



marigold, delphinium, and hollyhocks. Wait until the weather warms for heat-loving plants such as aster, zinnia, or dwarf dahlia

✓ Eliminate pests: If your garden is infested with aphids, release ladybugs (Sku 701166, \$9.99) at the

bottom of your plants at night, so

they'll stay to feast on these pests. Keep after snails and slugs using earth-friendly Sluggo (Sku

7117120, \$10.99). Don't let these pests get a foothold in your garden.

✓ **Weed:** Weeding when soil is wet and colder is easiest. Use a fork spade for larger weeding jobs and to turn soil (Sku 70091, \$29.99). Put weeds in a composter if you have one in your garden. After a few months, you can feed your garden with your compost.

Don't disturb tulips and daffodils:

These should be about finished blooming, but do not cut off the fading green foliage. It provides the nutrients needed for

✓ Fertilize: Add fertilizer now to citrus, roses, or summer-blooming shrubs if you did not fertilize last month.

Sensory Garden and Herbs

Children will have the opportunity to see, smell, and touch different types of plants as well as identify native California plants that they may see in their own neighborhood.



Companion **Planting**

Organic gardens are preferable to many Bay Area gardeners. In addition to enjoying healthier food crops from our garden, eliminating pesticides keeps our groundwater, which eventually makes its way to the Bay, safer. Companion planting can be used in a garden to obtain better crop harvests and avoid chemical fertilizers and pesticides.

To have an effective companion-planted garden, here are the basics:

- Apiaceae or aromatic flowering plants (celery, carrots, parsley) protect each other.
- Leguminous plants (peas, beans, clover) enrich soil with nitrogen. Planting them with tomatoes and cucumber, which need nitrogen, is recommended.
- Liliaceae (flowering plants that produce a lot of nectar and pollen to attract pollinators) and leguminous plants should be separated because they don't like each other.

Some example of associative planting:

- Garlic keeps away most insects and is compatible with carrots, beets, strawberries, and tomatoes.
- Dill protects carrots and cucumbers, and these do well when planted together.
- Basil is repulsive to flies and mosquitos and combines perfectly with tomatoes, asparagus, peppers, and eggplant.
- Borage, commonly known as starflower, attracts bees and helps with plant pollination. This plant scares away slugs and tomato worms. Potatoes, zucchini, cabbage, and strawberry plants will all appreciate borage.
- Chervil reduces the invasion of the slugs.
- Lavender repels aphids.
- Thyme keeps whiteflies at bay and protects cabbages and broccoli.

With this knowledge, you can enjoy a respectful approach to your garden and our environment.

Compost and Recycling

Kids can celebrate Earth Day by exploring the purpose of composting in terms of gardening and environmental impact; they'll also learn to identify proper recycling techniques.







