After the Dust Settles

As I write this in late November, it is raining cats and dogs. The smoky air from the disastrous Camp Fire in Paradise, which enveloped the Bay Area, thankfully has been washed away. We've gone from what we were calling "mask mania" to supplying urgent rain and flood protection products: umbrellas, dams to prevent flooding, roof cement, and more. As a business serving the community, we take our responsibility seriously to be here for you when crises, large or small, land on our doorstep.

We keep an extra-large inventory of many items that are critical in times of need: heaters to fend off the cold; fans and air conditioners to cool us in the heat; batteries, flashlights, and lanterns to keep us out of the dark during power outages; and much more.

Back-to-back years of catastrophic fires that brought unbelievable pollution remind us to add air respirators, air filters, and air purifiers to our list of crisis-related products to stockpile for the next time our community needs them.

During the recent Camp Fire, we moved mountains to keep respirator masks in stock. In fact, we supplied over 26,000 masks at price points ranging from \$1 up to \$50. Procurement was a challenge because all Northern California distributors were depleted. A team of folks at Cole Hardware worked hard to source masks and get them shipped in. I even drove 100 miles to stuff my car with boxes of masks that a trucking company wasn't able to deliver prior to the critical

Coins for the Community

With the generous contributions from our patrons, we've been busy raising much-needed funds for our Community Partners. In October, we collected \$3,462.85 for Bay Area Young Survivors cancer support organization. Our November collection started out raising funds

for Groceries for Seniors and St. Paul's Pantry for Hope, but after we saw the severity of the Camp Fire in Butte County, we switched to collecting for Caring Choices, a local nonprofit in Chico, where



go to the fire victims. Our December collection was earmarked for the W.O.M.A.N., Inc. domestic violence shelter and services, and we'll report on those numbers in our spring issue.

Here's a rundown of our November collections:

- We collected \$1,779.95 for Groceries for Seniors and St. Paul's Pantry of Hope in the first 12 days of November.
- We collected \$16,902.47 for Caring Choices November 13-30 for the Camp Fire victims.
- Cole Hardware made an additional \$10,000 donation to Caring Choices.
- Groceries for Seniors directed us to share half of their \$877.43 with Caring Choices.
- On Giving Tuesday, we raised \$4,805.00 for our W.O.M.A.N., Inc. Adopt-a-Family program.
- Cole Hardware also matched customer donations to the Camp Fire victims up to \$1,000 for the last four days of the month.

So, after all was said and done, Caring Choices received \$28,341.18 for the fire victims, Groceries for

Seniors received \$438.72, and St. Paul's got a check for \$902.52. This brings our grand total since our program began to \$196,390.81.

January:

Because of the shortened collection for our two favorite groups who feed seniors, we'll collect for the entire month of January for Groceries for Seniors and St. Paul's Pantry for Hope.

February:

For the month of February, we'll turn our focus to our four-legged friends at Muttville Senior Dog Rescue and the Milo Foundation. Muttville's mission is to change the way the world thinks about and treats older dogs and to create better lives for them through rescue, foster, adoption, hospice, education, and advocacy. In addition to cat and dog adoption at their Point Richmond location, the Milo Foundation has a sanctuary located on 283 acres in Mendocino County offering lots of room for the animals to run and play. The Milo Sanctuary houses primarily dogs and cats and an increasing number of horses, with the recent addition of the Milo Horse Rescue program. They also care for goats, donkeys, pigs, and feathered farm animals.

It's easy to donate to Coins for the Community! Simply drop your spare change in any of our collection jars or choose the "donate" option when you're checking out at any of our registers. Or bring in that old jar of pennies that's collecting dust on your dresser.

weekend they were needed. I am very proud of our staff, who worked tirelessly in the stores and behind the scenes.

And I am especially proud of you, our customers. As you checked out of our stores, you very generously donated nearly \$17,000 to add to our own donation of \$11,000 and over \$400 from our Groceries for Seniors collection. Caring Choices, a local nonprofit in Chico, was thrilled to receive our collective \$28,341.18 donation to the Camp Fire victim recovery fund.

Here's the big question for you: What will you do now to prepare for the ongoing challenges brought about by climate change? We're living with a new reality, and as we can see from the experiences of our



fellow citizens in Puerto Rico, Florida, North Carolina, California, and elsewhere, when crisis hits, chances are we will need to fend for ourselves. The City of San Francisco suggests preparing to sustain yourself for at least 36 hours. Whether it's a container for water storage, a portable

loo, first-aid supplies, or just about anything else you might need for your own 36-hour disaster kit, we can help advise and supply you and your family.

If you use a single-use coffee maker, you can now recycle all of your spent coffee pods at any Cole Hardware location. Please just make sure that they are clean before you bring them in. We will ship them to TerraCycle, an innovative recycling company that has become a global leader in recycling hard-to-recycle waste. The collected waste is mechanically and/or manually separated into metals, organics, and plastics. Metals are melted so that they can be recycled. Organics (such as the coffee grounds) are composted, and plastics undergo extrusion and pelletization to be molded

into new recycled plastic products. All varieties of used coffee or tea discs from any capsule-specific coffee or tea machine, including Freshpacks, K-Cups®, and T-Discs can be recycled at Cole Hardware.

changed when a property is bought, sold, or rented, which means former tenants and their friends, associates, and others might still have keys to your home. Marc suggests that in addition to rekeying locks, homeowners, business owners, and property managers should consider purchasing a lock system that will block unauthorized duplication of keys. This concept is called "key control." Cole Hardware carries locks that operate with high security and patented keys. Marc advises his customers to consider master key systems as another option.

When asked what advice he could give to our customers, Marc said, "Customers should consider getting a security consultation if they have any doubts or concerns about the overall security of their property. Additionally, they should install quality locks such as Schlage or high-security locks like Medeco." If a customer would like a security consultation, Marc can do a complete walk-through of the property. He will look for any security vulnerabilities and point out any substandard hardware (locks, windows, doors, and so on). He will then provide a written summary that will include suggestions as well as hardware recommendations. A standard security consultation is \$150. 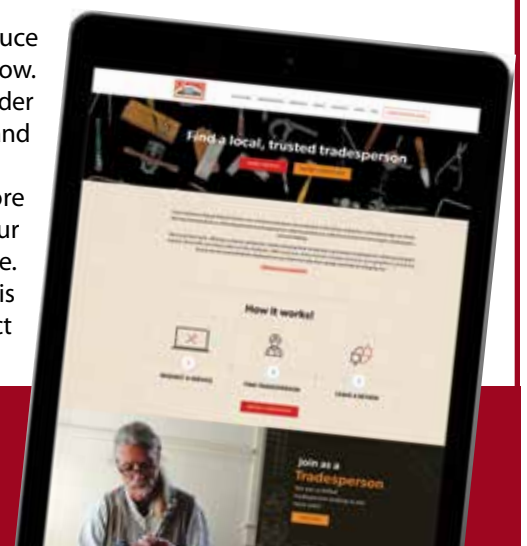

Snow Cable Chains

Veteran Tahoe travelers know that tire chains, also known as tire cables, are sometimes necessary when crossing the mountain passes in winter. These are sold by the pair and help car or truck tires get more traction in conditions where snow and/or ice have accumulated on the road. Four-wheel-drive and all-wheel-drive vehicles with snow tires used to be exempt from chain controls, but no longer. All vehicles must now carry chains to enter a chain-control area.

Our Cobra™ cable chains feature tough carbon-steel rollers that provide traction and long wear. The low-profile steel rollers allow increased tire-to-road contact, resulting in better stability, plus a considerable reduction in noise and vibration, and they are galvanized for rust prevention.

All Cole Hardware locations stock four of the most popular size cables for cars (Sku 818818–21, \$46.99–\$49.99) and a popular truck size (Sku 818822, \$99.99). Just bring in your specific tire size as set forth by the ISO metric tire code. Virtually all tires have this information molded into the sidewalls, or you can refer to the factory specs for tires if the tires have not been changed on your car since you purchased it.

What if we don't carry your size? No worries! We can special order the chains for you. Just come in with your tire size by Monday, and if we don't have the size you need, we'll order them and have them in our store for you by Thursday of that week.

IMPORTANT! If you buy a pair of Cobra cable chains, you must use a pair of tensioners with them. These are essentially six small, rubber, bungee-type cords bound by a circular rubber piece in the center, and come two to a bag. (Sku 818823, \$12.99) This is an integral part of the Cobra system and cannot be omitted.

Heat It Up!

Choose a Heater That Suits Your Needs

Old Victorians offer a lot of character and charm: high ceilings, spacious flats with long hallways, hardwood floors, sweeping views from big picture windows. Often though, this old-world charm translates into old-world, unreliable heating systems. An alternative to installing an expensive forced air heating system is to use space heaters and heat only the rooms necessary. Radiant and convection heating are the main types of space heaters, and each has its own benefits for heating a room. Cole Hardware offers a variety of heaters, so you can choose one that best suits your needs.

Radiant Heating

Convection heaters directly heat the air. Cool air enters the bottom of the heater, is warmed, and rises out of the top of the heater and to ceiling level. This type of heater will heat a room from the top down, unless a ceiling fan is used to circulate the room air. Convection heaters are best used when you need a good amount of heat in a short time in a well-insulated room.

Ceramic heaters provide quick, focused heating and warm air by heating a ceramic element inside the unit and using a fan to either push or pull air over the hot element. Fairly portable because of their light weight, they tend to offer a smaller set of features than fan heaters, but they can heat the air to a higher temperature. (Skus 6403372, \$35.99; 6266878, \$41.99)

Fan heaters provide powerful, directional heat and warm the air by heating an element inside the unit and using a fan to push or pull air over the hot element. Fan-forced convection heaters are very effective as they blow warm air out of the bottom and can usually be moved easily from room to room. (Skus 6403398, \$29.99; 6167118, \$31.99; 6103071, \$89.99; 6208516, \$99.99)

Convection Heating

Using infrared radiation, radiant heaters create a region of comfort in front of the heater and do not heat the air directly. Instead, these heaters will warm a room over time. Best used to heat poorly insulated or draughty, high-ceilinged rooms, some radiant heaters have a visible source of heat that glows bright red.

Oil-filled radiators are powered

by electricity and are an incredibly economical heater. The element inside the heater heats up sealed thermal oil that never needs to be replaced. The oil heats the radiator fins, which heat the air, and although these heaters take longer to activate, the heat can last longer. These heaters are ideal for rooms that you want to heat for a longer period of time, such as a bedroom, but they can be less portable because of size and weight. Baseboard heaters radiate heat upward, heating the air directly above. These heaters are commonly used under a window or in other drafty areas because they heat the cold air stream entering the room and spread the warm air. Baseboard heaters should never be used near draperies or flammable materials. Because these heaters tend to be 3 to 4 feet in length, the spaces where they can be used might be limiting. (Sku 6314736, \$74.99)



Although there are relatively few creeks or streams in our urban areas, flooding still occurs during heavy downpours in driveways and backyards. Clogged storm drains are another cause of flooding on city streets. Be prepared to protect flood-prone areas around your house with Quick Dam. These flood bags and barriers work similarly to sandbags in diverting water, but they are much more convenient—no heavy

sand to lug around, for one thing!

Compact and lightweight, these reusable barriers activate and swell when wet and evaporate when dry. They'll reactivate when wet again and degrade naturally after several months of ongoing use, so they should last well through our rainy season. Available in a 6-pack of bags (Sku 5681689, \$39.99) or a 10-foot barrier (Sku 5681622, \$24.99).

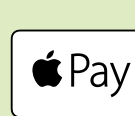

Be Prepared

The Camp Fire and the bad air quality that blanketed the Bay Area caught many of us off guard. Unfortunately, some reports indicate that big fires that frequent California could occur year-round, especially when we're in one of our drought years. The items listed below are good to keep in your home's emergency kit, although the air purifier can certainly be used any time, especially if you like to keep your windows open.

Simply tape the filter to the back of the fan with the arrow on the filter pointing in the direction of the air flow.

In the Garden Garden Tasks

Tips from Our Garden Expert

January:

January is an excellent time of year to plan what you will grow in your garden in the upcoming months. Browse seed catalogs, magazines, and books for inspiration to find the look and feel of your spring garden. Be bold and resolve to grow some new types of plants that you haven't tried before.

✓ Living Christmas trees should be outside by now. Keep them well watered in their pots or plant them, but remember that they will grow large!

✓ Take advantage of our usually wet weather and capture rainwater to use for your garden on dry days. A low-tech rainwater system as simple as placing indoor plants outside during a rain or using empty buckets to collect rain will work.

Or you can invest in a rain barrel to place under your downspout to collect larger quantities. Our Cole Valley store stocks a 50-gallon box-style rain barrel. (Sku 7205396, \$99.99) All other locations can special order this item.



✓ Now is the time to plant bare root roses, as well as asparagus and artichokes.

✓ Newly planted trees may need some support as they grow large enough to stand on their own. Use arbor stakes and cross braces as needed to secure trees. Ties should be loose so that the tree can move enough to grow independently. (5-foot Redwood Stake: Sku 76698, \$2.59)



✓ Mulch for weed suppression and to protect plant roots. Use bark, straw, sawdust, leaves, or peat moss as needed around plants and to add paths in your garden. Weed before applying an approximately 2-inch layer of mulch, keeping it at least an inch away from a tree trunk or plant stem. (Mulch: Sku 75958, \$8.99; Bark: Sku 7094212, \$8.99)

✓ Pruning of trees, roses, and perennials should be completed this month.

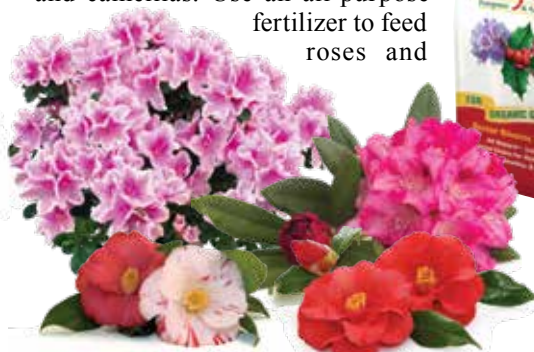


✓ Don't let your fireplace ashes go to waste. Use them to fertilize irises and other alkaline-loving plants.

February:

February can sometimes be a difficult month to actually be in the garden, as the weather may still be cold and wet in the Bay Area. At least it is a short month! There are, however, some essential tasks that should not be ignored. And don't forget Valentine's Day! A beautiful plant will be a daily reminder to your loved one.

✓ Mid- to late-February is the time to fertilize shrubs and evergreens. Use an acid-type fertilizer to feed evergreens, conifers, broadleaf evergreens, rhododendrons, azaleas, and camellias. Use an all-purpose fertilizer to feed roses and



other deciduous trees and shrubs. Apply dormant spray (horticultural oil) to fruit trees to kill overwintering insect eggs.

✓ Prune winter-flowering shrubs and vines just after blooming. Prune your summer-flowering shrubs, but be aware that spring bloomers already produced their buds last fall, and pruning them now will result in the loss of flowers. Deciduous trees should be pruned, too.

✓ Keep after snails and slugs with Sluggo®, which is safe to use around pets and wildlife. Available in assorted sizes including 1 pound (Sku 7117120, \$10.99) and 2½ pounds (Sku 7096258, \$19.99).



✓ House plants may notice the longer days and begin growing. You can begin feeding them again, but dilute your fertilizer mix by 50% until the growth is robust.

✓ Feed the birds so that they can help control insects once the weather warms up.

✓ Winter weeds should be pulled as they emerge. Oxalis and nutsedge should be dug out to remove their underground bulbs.

✓ Cymbidiums will be blooming now. Feed those that have *not* bloomed yet. Do not feed those currently blooming. Divide them after they have bloomed.

✓ Repot cacti and succulents (if they seem too big for their pots) once they have finished blooming.

✓ Daffodils will be blooming. Remember not to cut off the tall green leaves from the bulb. These are needed to provide nutrients to next year's blooms.

✓ Fertilize bulbs just as their foliage begins to emerge. Bulbs blooming soon include tulips, daffodils, hyacinths, and narcissus.

✓ Plant this month:

- Bare-root roses and fruit trees can still be planted.
- Sow seeds for hardy spring blooming annuals outdoors.
- Warm-season annuals and vegetables and tender perennials can be sown indoor.
- Sow seeds and plant seedlings of cool-season or winter vegetables, including rhubarb, asparagus, and artichokes.
- Gladiolas for spring or fall blooms can be planted now. Don't forget that gladiolas like rich, fast-draining (sandy) soil and lots of sun.
- Strawberries can be planted this month, too.

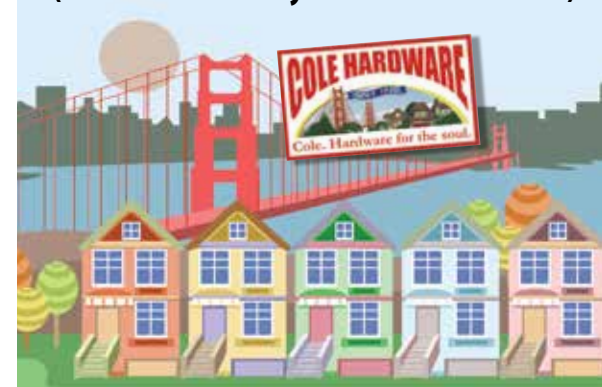
